

***QUESTIONS ADDRESSED TO THE OCA CHANCELLOR  
and OCA SECRETARY in a phone conversation:  
September 13, 2012 ...***

Fr. V. Susan:           Calling: 1 – 516 – 922 – 0550 ... at 9: 19 a.m.

Receptionist:           Orthodox Church in America

Fr. V. Susan:           Good morning to you! I'm Fr Susan in Chicago, IL. May I talk to Fr Chancellor ...?  
Please.

Receptionist:           Good morning! Let me try to track him down. Hold on.

Fr. V. Susan:           Thank you very much!

Receptionist:           Transferring.

Fr. V. Susan:           Thank you!

Fr. J. Jillions:           Fr John Jillions.

Fr. V. Susan:           Good morning to you Fr Chancellor! Fr Susan in Chicago, IL! How are you ...?

Fr. J. Jillions:           I am fine Fr. I am having here Fr Tosi as well.

Fr. E. G. Tosi           Good morning, Fr!

Fr. V. Susan:           Good morning to you brothers!  
I am OCA Stavropegial Priest for over 8 years ... and I am asking you brotherly  
permission to talk to you if possible!

Fr. J. Jillions:           We're here.

Fr. V. Susan:           OK. I would like to ask you something:

Please, let me know, how can I get some help from you in regards to the Report or  
Formal Complaint I made on June 23, 2005, to the OCA Synod, in regards to a cover  
up of an OCA / ROEA homosexual / sodomite priest under the name of B ...?

Fr. J. Jillions:           Everything we know is here. I have all your informations.

Fr. V. Susan:           How can I get help from you ...?

Fr. J. Jillions:           Yes.

You've made a Formal Complaint...?

Fr. V. Susan:           Of course Fr.

Fr. J. Jillions:           You made a lawsuit against the Church ... right?

- Fr. V. Susan: Fr. This is something else, not involving the homosexual priest. I am talking about the homosexual priest B. only.
- Fr. J. Jillions: *He is no longer a priest in the OCA. You know that.*
- Fr. V. Susan: OK. I like to ask you something.  
Please, let me know who is in charge for the Office of Review of Sexual Misconduct Allegations ... according to the ... *Policies, Standards, and Procedures of the OCA on Sexual Misconduct 2003 ... ?*
- Fr J. Jillions: That would be me.
- Fr. V. Susan: OK!  
And also let me know “IF” you are familiar with the ... *Policies, Standards, and Procedures of the OCA on Sexual Misconduct of 2003 ... ?*
- Fr J. Jillions: I am.
- Fr. V. Susan: And also ... according to the Chapter 7 ... *of the ... Policies, Standards, Procedures of the OCA on Sexual Misconduct 2003 ... entitled ... Church Structure Concerning Sexual Misconduct Allegations ... it’s talking on ... about the Authority of Bishops ...*  
And also ... in there ... there are some provisions regarding the authority of the Bishops and the obligations of the Bishop to report to the Synod such a sexual misconduct.  
Are you familiar with that?
- Fr J. Jillions: Yes ...?
- Fr. V. Susan: OK.  
  
I know that is true, that the “Office” ... shall be under the authority of the Primate of the Church, and shall be responsible to the Holy Synod of Bishops, and shall be supervised on a day-to-day basis by the Chancellor of the Church.  
Is that true ...?
- Fr J. Jillions: That’s true.
- Fr. V. Susan: OK.  
Of course you are familiar with the responsibilities and provisions from Chapter 7, regarding the duties and responsibilities for reviews and investigations.
- Fr J. Jillions: That’s right.
- Fr. V. Susan: I was never interviewed and the charges were never reviewed by so called “*Office of Review of Sexual Misconduct Allegations’ Investigator.*”  
Why ...? From 2005 until 2012 ... over 7 years ...?  
  
*Who is covering up, what, for what purpose and for whose sake ... ?*
- Fr J. Jillions: So ... you are saying you submitted the Complaint in 2005, you were never interviewed, and the charges were never reviewed.

Fr. V. Susan: Correct ... and I have correspondences in writing. They are part file of mine ... within the OCA Chancery, signed by Metropolitan Herman, signed by Fr. Kondratick (former OCA's Chancellor), signed by Fr Alexey Karlgut (former "Office of Review of Sexual Misconduct Allegations' Investigator"). I have a lot of proof ... and more than that.

Fr J. Jillions: So ... what was Fr Karlgut contacting you ... ?

Fr. V. Susan: He contacted me and he told me, I am going to be interviewed ... and to bring the case for a closure.

Why nobody did show up in Chicago ... ?

Why nobody called me in to interview me and defrock the homosexual priest ... ?

Who is in between ... ? +Nathaniel ... ? +Herman ... ? ... or, who else ... ?

Fr. V. Susan: My file is in Syosset.

You know that the Internet presents such rumors in there ...

I'm sick and tired by the Internet and the case was never resolved by Syosset.

I have a lot of respect for the OCA.

But, good people in charge, or bad people in charge in the OCA, they covered up for so many years.

It is not going to stay so anymore.

Fr. V. Susan: Also ... are you familiar that ..., the Synod of Bishops received the Complaint ... dated 23 of June, 2005 ... signed by me (Rev Fr Vasile Susan) ... and sent to their attention ... pressing charges on B. ... or you are not familiar ... and Fr Tosi too?

Fr J. Jillions: I am familiar.

Fr. V. Susan: Brother, I will go one more step.

Also ... the Spiritual Consistory of the ROEA (I was part of) ... finished the job.

All the materials are in there (in Syosset) ... and regretfully I feel very sorry to say to you that ... some hierarchs and priests in the OCA ... they are preaching God ... and are practicing evil ... All the files that have been in the OCA Chancery (?) ... had been taken in consideration ... but mine ... ? I am very much frustrated about this ... and I feel very sorry for the fact that ... for over 8 years ... I was attached to the St. Sergius of Radonezh Chapel ... in Syosset, ... to dry out ...

Do you think God is blind ... ? God is deaf ... ? ... or some good people within the OCA ... like good priests ... too ... ?

What do you think ... brothers ... ?

Fr. Susan: Hello ... ?

Fr J. Jillions: I am listening ... !

Fr. V. Susan: Then, how come that the "*Office of Review of Sexual Misconduct Allegations' Investigator*" ... put in charge (by Metropolitan Jonah) Fr Gregory Jensen ... instead of Fr Alexey Karlgut ... ?

- Fr. Susan: Who did give him the opportunity to get access to my materials ...?  
I have had the opportunity to communicate electronically, via e-mail with Fr Jensen.
- Fr J. Jillions: I did not catch the last name you mentioned ... which priest...?
- Fr. V. Susan: Gregory Jensen.
- Fr J. Jillions: Jensen.
- Fr. V. Susan: He was demoted from his position because he was not well qualified ... and ... well qualified was not even Alexey Karlgut. But, Alexey Karlgut had the opportunity to twist around the case of Eric Illif, and to make the job done according to the prescriptions of "somebody else."
- Fr. E. G. Tosi: Fr, this is Fr Eric.  
  
I have two (2) points I want to make:  
Fr Gregory Jensen never had a position here in the "*Office of Review of Sexual Misconduct Allegations.*"  
He was an advisor. He was never involved officially or unofficially with this Office. Any material that was sent to him was improper, because he was not in such a position. In fact we discovered that he was not in such a position. As advisor, he was not qualified. I do not know how Fr Jensen got involved in this. How you would like to explain this. I know he should not be.
- Fr. Susan: I explain it right away if you like me to do that.
- Fr. E. G. Tosi: Fr. ... it was about a year ago, Fr Alexander Garklavs contacted you about coming to meet with the Holy Synod ... to present your case ... and you could not come because of your schedule ...? Is that correct?
- Fr. Susan: That is correct ... but that kind of meeting was related to the civil lawsuit, and not to the case against Fr. B.
- Fr. E. G. Tosi: I understood that it was the chance to present your allegations to the Holy Synod on the Fr. B. case. I would like to believe that.
- Fr. Susan: I believe the other way. My attorney told me that it is not the proper time to go.
- Fr. E. G. Tosi: So, your lawyer decided that. I just wish to clarify that between us.  
Fr Garklavs decided that and it was set up ... and we were let to believe that you will be working out with the schedule problems.
- Fr. V. Susan: Yes. I could not come without my attorney. My attorney did not have his schedule available. And on top of it, my attorney was very much disturbed by the proposal done by Fr Alexander Garklavs (the former OCA Chancellor), at the advice of either +Nathaniel, or Holy Synod, or Metropolitan +Jonah, trying to brainwash me ... to withdraw the case from the civil court, and then to accept an appointment for a parish. The Metropolitan was not even a diocesan bishop at that time.  
Who can be so stupid? ... Not me!  
  
My attorney learned something about the OCA.

Fr. Susan: I like to ask you for something else.

Fr. E. G. Tosi: About Fr Gregory Jensen!

Fr. Susan: Fr G. Jensen carried on the e-mails and correspondences with me. I asked him if he is going to be the "Chef Investigator" ... according to Mark Stokoe. He replied to me saying: I am not. All my e-mails exchanged between the two, (between he (Fr Gregory Jensen and me) are part of the file in Syosset, because he turned over everything. I am upset about this.

He turned over my e-mails to the OCA when he was terminated from his position as an advisor, or whatever position he had in there.

Fr. E. G. Tosi: He was never hired, so I do not know how he got involved in your case. He had any authority to do that.

Fr. V. Susan: Brothers, I like to tell you something.

Do you read the Minutes of the Holy Synod or of the Metropolitan Council ...?

Do you have the gift to keep in your memory whatever you read in there ...?

In there (in the Minutes) ... is printed *black on white* ... that Fr. Jensen turned over everything ... including electronically communications?

By the way ... *the SMPAC Report in Santa Fe had only 9 pages*, is posted over the Internet right now. In Chicago it was *presented one of over 650 pages ... and over one hundred footnotes (in reality over 150 footnotes), and (in reality 50 page) other materials.*

*In the Minutes of the Metropolitan Council and the OCA Holy Synod in Chicago, IL, last year, is printed black on white, whatever Fr. Jensen turned over, including electronically communications.*

Fr. E. G. Tosi: Fr, I am not disagreeing with you that what the people put all the Minutes together.

I am surprised that the *Confidential Report (SMPAC Report)* to the Holy Synod, **that you have it**, as well as of the other things. **Those were not the Official Minutes. They were not to be ever made known to the public. That was an issue that we can speak about. That is part of the problems we are having here.**

I am aware of the Fr. Jensen situation. I am aware of the SMPAC Report and of the people inside of that report. I do understand that you know that!

Fr J. Jillions: **Right now the bottom line is that Fr. B. is no longer a priest in the OCA.**

Fr. V. Susan: Thank you brother for bringing to my attention such an issue.

I am looking attentively over the OCA site almost every day, if possible twice. I am watching "*the pastoral changes*" and this *kind of scheme*, orchestrated by +Nathaniel and some other OCA Central Administration people. This took place after you took charge over the OCA's position as a Chancellor.

Is that correct?

Fr J. Jillions: It has happened just at that time ... if I recall.

- Fr. V. Susan: *Why it was not published in the pastoral changes by the OCA ...?*
- Fr J. Jillions: Because when a priest is not ... aaaaaaa
- Fr. E. G. Tosi: I can tell you why ...? Because when we were doing our research of Fr. B. ... we found out that he was never ... How I put this ... **He was released to the winds** ... (diocese ...?). **It was such an artificial gen of release.**
- Fr. V. Susan: To whom ...?
- Fr. E. G. Tosi: Metropolitan Herman never received him. So, he case was in fact in a **“LIMBO SITUATION”** ... When we look at that, we realized that, that man is not a member of the Romanian Diocese. He has not being accepted by the OCA **“at large”** ... He is out there. We think, we wrote him a letter, **saying you are no longer a clergyman of the OCA.**
- Fr. V. Susan: I like to get that letter!
- Fr. E. G. Tosi: **That regular situation happened.**
- Fr. V. Susan: May I get that letter that you've sent to Fr. B. ...?
- Fr. E. G. Tosi: No, it can't go ...
- Fr. V. Susan: No problem my brother. It was a matter of questioning my brother.
- I have another question for you ...?
- Do you know that he was a homosexual ...?**
- Fr. E. G. Tosi: That's not a problem for me ...!
- Fr. V. Susan: Did the OCA finish the file ...?
- Fr J. Jillions: It was that [ORSMA] completed the file ... **we closed the file as far as we know on Fr. B.**
- Fr. V. Susan: Why did you close the file ... if the file was not resolved ...? Why ...?
- Fr J. Jillions: **He was no longer a priest in the OCA.**
- Fr. V. Susan: There is no priest in the Orthodox World without the umbrella of a Bishop.
- Why did you release him ...?
- Did Nathaniel lobby to you ... to let him ... to go ...!?
- Is this the way you did ...?
- Why you did not publish his release into the OCA's newspaper ...?

Fr. E. G. Tosi: *He was released ... and we simple say: you are not a priest of the OCA.*

Fr. V. Susan: I truly respect your view point. I like to thank you very much for your time.  
*A civil action in court is going to be taken in consideration by my attorney.*  
And don't forget ... somebody will pay the price.  
Thank you very much!

Fr J. Jillions: Thank you for calling Fr.

Fr. V. Susan: No problem. I will post over the Internet whatever I have. I will present the story the way I have to do. God bless you!

Fr. E. G. Tosi: Thank you Fr.

Fr, I have one more question:

*What do you want us to do ...?*

*What can we do to help you with ...?*

Fr. V. Susan: Nr. 1. To resolve the case of Fr. B. according to the provisions of the **“Policy”** (namely ... *Policies, Standards, and Procedures of the OCA on Sexual Misconduct 2003*); ... and of the provisions of the **“Canons”** ... (Orthodox Church Canonical provisions). Then, to get rid of the belligerent bishops, and dirty Bishops.  
Got it ...?

Fr J. Jillions: Get it!

Fr. V. Susan: Nr. 2. I like for you to re-open the case of Fr. B.  
Fr. B. is over the Ukrainians ...  
Would you like me to come to Parma Heights ...?  
I am not that kind of priest ... But I will use **“the professionals’ channels”**.  
I have many attorneys.  
I'll demonstrate to you from now on **“who's who.”**  
I thank you for your time.  
I am not going to give up in my endeavor, until I'll finish the game.  
You've had the “ball” in your field for seven years, and you let him go.  
No problem! Somebody we'll get a lesson from this. Have a good day brothers!

Fr. E. G. Tosi: Thank you Fr.

Fr J. Jillions: Bye Fr!

Fr. V. Susan: Bye!
